

Pop Corn Cart

Note

- Beware of parts which will be hot during operation and may cause burns if contacted.
- Do not tip water into a hot kettle.
- Use caution when using electrical appliance. Ensure all leads are free from breakage and check for exposed wiring.

Transport and Set Up

- Note that the upper glass cabinet and the cart are separate for ease of transport. Take care when moving the cart as the glass cabinet may slide off the cart if care is not taken.
- Transport with care on a stable surface and strapped in to prevent damage to glass and other components.
- Two people are needed to lift.
- Set up the cart in an area not likely to be affected by adverse weather. Once in position lock castors by pushing locking lever down.

Operation

1. Plug cord into a power socket and switch on.
2. Press the red Warming and Light switch to on position (1). This can stay on during the event.
3. Press the green Heat switch to the on position (2) and allow 3 - 4 minutes for the popping kettle to heat up.
4. Press the green Turn switch to the on position (3) once the kettle has heated up and immediately place into the kettle 50ml of oil and 150g of popping corn. **Caution: the kettle will be hot and contact with the hand may cause burns.**
5. Lower the kettle lid (4) and close the doors.
6. The corn will begin to pop after a minute or two and when you do not hear any more popping open the doors, raise the kettle lid and turn the kettle lever (5) to swing the kettle open and tip out popped corn into the cabinet.
7. Sprinkle a teaspoon of flavoured salt over popped corn and mix in. Add more or less to taste.
8. Repeat steps 4 to 6 to make more popcorn.
9. When the popping kettle is not in use press the green Turning and Heat switches to the off position.
10. Once finished ensure all switches are in the off position.



Cleaning

- Once kettle has cooled down use a paper towel to wipe out residue oil. Never pour water into kettle especially when it is still hot as this may cause water and oil to splash onto the hands or in face causing burns.
- Wipe down inside of cabinet to clean using a damp cloth.
- Pull out tray (6) and tip out any un-popped corn and return to position.

Quantities

- 150g of un-popped corn will make approx. 20 cups of popcorn.
